Mobile Plant Mechanic

Reporting to Service Coordinator

Purpose: To maintain and repair various types of mobile plant equipment used primarily in construction, agriculture and material handling.

Key Requirements

- High school diploma or equivalent. Formal technical training or certification in heavy equipment mechanics is preferred.
- Proven experience as a Mobile Plant Mechanic or in a similar role, 3 to 5 years preferred.
- Strong mechanical, electrical, and hydraulic knowledge related to mobile plant equipment.
- Proficiency in diagnosing and troubleshooting technical issues using diagnostic tools and manuals.
- Ability to read and interpret technical manuals, schematics, and drawings.
- Knowledge of safety regulations and practices in the heavy equipment industry.
- Excellent problem-solving skills and attention to detail.
- Physical stamina and ability to work in various weather conditions and challenging environments.
- Strong communication skills and ability to work as part of a team.

Key Accountabilities

Equipment Maintenance and Repairs:

- Perform regular inspections, maintenance, and repairs on mobile plant machinery and equipment, including excavators, loaders, forklifts, telehandlers, tractors, and other heavy machinery.
- Diagnose mechanical, electrical, and hydraulic issues and troubleshoot problems using technical manuals, diagnostic equipment, and hand tools.
- Repair or replace faulty components, parts, and systems to restore equipment to optimal working condition.
- Maintain detailed records of all inspection, maintenance and repair activities performed on each piece of equipment to support customer communication and invoicing.
- Provide timely and accurate reports on equipment status, maintenance history, and repair activities as required.
- Attend customer sites to perform equipment maintenance and repairs using company service vehicles throughout Regional Victoria.
- Ensure that all equipment meets safety standards and regulatory requirements.

Equipment Testing and Calibration:

- Conduct performance tests and calibration checks on equipment after repairs or maintenance to verify proper functioning.
- Use specialised diagnostic tools and equipment to identify and address performance issues.

Parts and Inventory Management:

- Identify required replacement parts and components and coordinate with the Parts team to ensure their timely availability.
- Maintain an organised inventory of spare parts and consumables required for equipment maintenance and repair in your work area and the broader workshop.

Teamwork and Communication:

- Collaborate with other mechanics, technicians, and team members to share knowledge and solve complex technical problems.
- Communicate effectively with supervisors and operators to understand equipment issues and provide feedback on repairs and maintenance.

Training and Development:

- Stay updated with advancements in mobile plant technology and industry best practices through training and self-development.
- Provide guidance and training to apprentices and junior mechanics to develop their skills and knowledge.
- Keep up-to-date with industry regulations and safety practices related to mobile plant machinery.
